Dedication Program Details

New items are added to the Airpark between May-October. Please allow up to 4-6 months processing and installation time. All dedication items are made from long-lasting 100% recycled UV-protected plastic and include a 2" x 5" plaque with up to four lines of text. 1 in 5 picnic tables will be an accessible version, at the discretion of the NAFMC staff.

The dedication item will be maintained in the RCAF Memorial Airpark for a minimum of ten (10) years, at no additional cost to the donor. If after this time it needs to be replaced, the donor will be given first chance to make a new donation for a new dedication item in the same location. If they cannot be reached, or decide not to donate for a new dedication item, the item will be removed when it is no longer safe/appropriate to be in the Airpark. The plaque will be removed from the item and made available for the donor. It will be held by the NAFMC for 90 days.
