Halifax NA 337 is the only fully restored Halifax bomber on display in the world. Interior tours of the aircraft are available via a booking request, some restrictions apply. Please review the information below prior to your tour.

COST – BY DONATION

- A minimum donation of **\$200 per person** is required.
- A tax receipt for the total amount of your donation is available by request. Please indicate on the booking form if you would like a tax receipt and provide your full mailing address.
- Payment is due on-site prior to your tour; the Museum accepts cash, cheque, debit, or credit.

COMPLIMENTARY TOURS are available to Second World War veterans (+1 guest) who flew in or supported Halifax operations. Please indicate in your booking request if you meet these criteria.

TOUR OVERVIEW AND REQUIREMENTS

All interior tours of Halifax NA 337 are guided and there is a maximum of two (2) guests allowed inside the aircraft with a guide at a time. **Visitors must be 18 years of age or older to enter the aircraft.**

Entering, exiting, and navigating through the aircraft may be difficult for some visitors. For the best possible tour experience, we advise that you:

- are able to climb a step ladder to independently enter and exit the aircraft through a hatch;
- are able to walk on an incline;
- are able to step over obstacles up to 30cm off the ground;
- wear appropriate footwear (running shoes, sneakers) and long pants.

Prior to entering the aircraft, visitors are given a briefing that will cover:

- the fuselage angle (the false perception of the aircraft as level)
- the dangers of a variety of protruding edges and objects
- that low level radiation has been detected around the aircraft instruments. These levels are well within the Government of Canada's safety guide for short term exposure, however, for this reason access to the aircraft is **restricted for individuals under the age of 18 and those who are pregnant.**

Visitors must follow the direction provided by the tour guide and respect the aircraft by following the rules and regulations, including:

- the **only** seats that can be sat in are the **navigator's position** and the **centre spar section benches**;
- handles and switches cannot be touched or manipulated.

PHOTOGRAPHY for personal use is permitted. Filming / recording of the tour / tour guide is not permitted.
